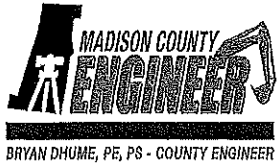

To the Board of County Commissioners Madison County, Ohio:

The undersigned County Engineer, in obedience to the order of your Board, made on the 25th day of August, 2020, proceeded in the above matter, and visited the proposed location of said improvement and made the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, as found by the Commissioners, plans for structures, maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed, and profiles showing the existing and gradient of the improvement, and made an estimate of the actual cost of the construction together with the cost of engineering and the cost of notices, publication and other incidental expenses, of said improvement, and set proper construction stakes, beginning at the upper terminus of the improvement, and noted the intersection of the line of the improvement with the apparent land boundaries of separate owners, township and county lines, natural land marks, road crossings, or other lines or marks; and took and noted necessary levels of the lines of the improvement for contour purposes, to determine the area, of the land subject to drainage, and to determine the extent of benefits to the land affected by the construction of the improvement.

I also established, at intervals of not less than one in each mile, in the most practical, permanent form, and in locations where destruction or disturbance is improbable, bench marks from which the original levels of the improvement can be established. The relation of the assumed elevation used by me in my work upon this improvement, to the established elevation

Of the geodetical survey of the United States, in the County, is as follows:

I also made a schedule of the work proposed to be done, showing the fall, the depth, the excavating to be done, the location of the permanent bench marks and their actual elevation above or below the base elevation used, the nature of the excavation, and the location of quicksand or rock, or other special features.

I also prepared a schedule containing the name of each owner of land, with a description of the land which I believe to be benefited by the proposed improvement, taken from the tax duplicates of the County, and have entered in said schedule the proximate number of acres benefited by the proposed improvement, and the amount that said land, in my opinion, ought to be assessed, according to benefits.

I also prepared proper working specifications for the construction of the improvement, including catch basins, retaining walls, size and kind of tile, and included an easement of sufficient width for permanent maintenance, etc.

I made estimates of the cost of excavating and of the cost of material and divided the construction of said improvement into such working sections as were deemed expedient.

The said survey, maps, profiles, plans, schedules, and reports are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

I hereby recommend the Gannon Ditch maintenance district in which this improvement shall be placed, and I have included \$ in the construction costs for the maintenance of said district for one year.

My estimate of the cost of the construction of said improvement is as follows:

Residential:
 2 residents experience severe flooding which can cause leach fields to fail (\$7,000 ea.). Resale values can be effected by 5% to 10% because of water issues (3 Combined - \$20,000). Will protect perimeter drain and sump pump with a good outlet. (3 homes - \$15,000)

Agriculture:
 By improving with open ditch, the systems will work more efficiently. Systematic tilling can increase production 10-15%. Just improving the tile/open ditch could increase production by 5%.

Farlinger has 4 acres down out. Assume 50% increase for event once every 3 years gives approx. \$600 payback.

Another 560 acres should see an increase in 5% due to the improved tile/open ditch system. Assume crop rotation and event once every three years gives - \$8500 payback per year average.

Residential and agricultural benefits are approximately \$30,000. This gives payback less than 4 years.

Bethel/Fornoff 350 acres will see increase approximately \$5,000/year which gives a payback of 10 years.

Based on these numbers, we believe the benefits outweigh the costs and the drainage system consisting of an open ditch starting at the existing headwall on the lands of Roger Snyder and extending 5500' easterly to the lands of Robert Peninger and extending 2 waterways through the Vernon Wick property ending at Becker Road, placing the open ditch, tile and waterway on County Maintenance to be known as the Gannon Ditch #214.





The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Course and Termini:

Starting at the existing headwall of the Gannon Ditch on the lands of Roger Snyder and going in a southwesterly direction through the lands of RD Snyder Farms, Inc. and Roger Snyder, thence in a westerly direction through the lands of James & Darlene Becker, William & Donna Becker, Brent & Ashley Thomas, under Thomas Road and through the lands of Robert Persinger to a point to be determined in order to achieve adequate surface and subsurface drainage.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land except as ordered under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for:

Re-establish surface and subsurface drainages for drainage issues in the Gannon Ditch watershed and place system known as the Gannon Ditch on County Maintenance.
