

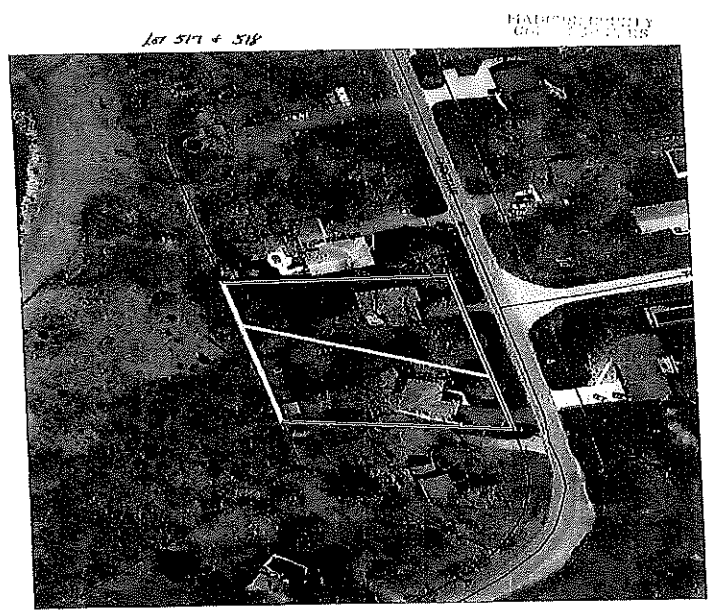
To review a plat amendment of lot 517 & 518 Lake Choctaw Subdivision in Somerford Township for approved and signatures.

Chairman Mike Boerger adjourned the meeting.

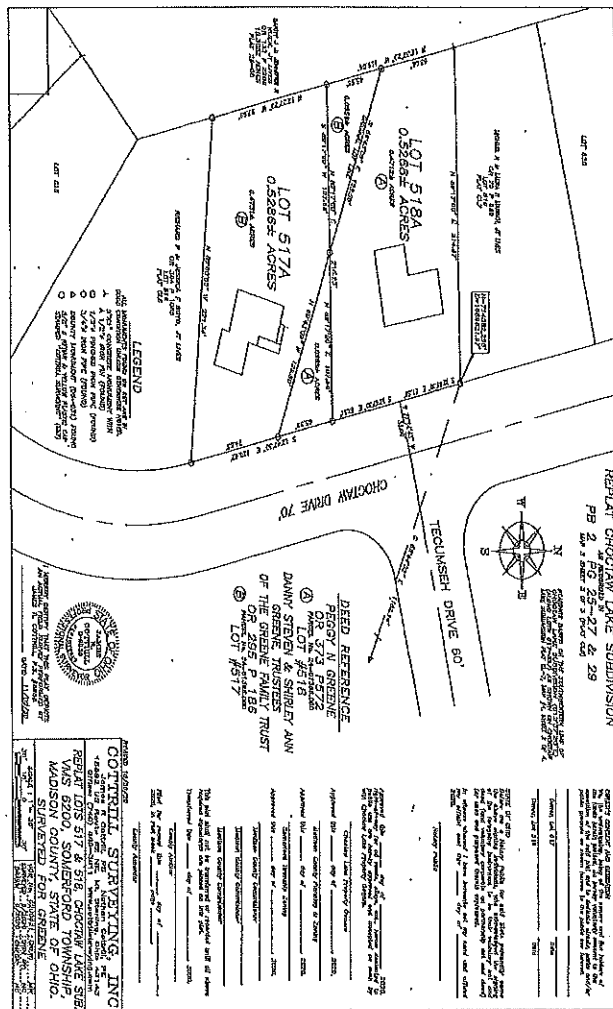
