

Jeff Coleman, Deputy Engineer, reported that:

- Mowing will begin along the bike trails on April 25th
- The Knox Box is operating now.
- Will attempt to spray for honey suckle this spring and fall weather permitting.
- The waterline at the Prairie Grass Trail had to be repaired because it was frozen during the winter. The water fountain has now been turned back on.

FMCP Report

Wayne Roberts reported that:

- Three design mural sketches would be helpful.
May look into placing some type of brick walkway to lead up to mural site.
There have been businesses in London that has made a donation to the trail town project.
- The trail counts for March 2022 was 1858 on the east side and 1244 on the west side. Wayne believes with the east side count being increased that there are more bike riders coming from the Columbus area.
There have only been four campers in the month of March, but will be increasing as the warm weather approaches.
- The Pancake & Sausage breakfast silent auction was at an all time high for individuals who participated using the on line auction option.

Old Business

- The Spring volunteer event at the Little Darby Preserve is scheduled for April 28th rain date of May 4th.
- According to ODNR - Due to the weather issues there will not be a burn this year. Will look into this as an option in the future

New Business

- Five volunteers logged 61.5 hours in March and that number has increased due to more volunteers.
- There will be a Marathon race to take place in London on April 30th.

Dear Senator Brown:

I'm writing in support of the \$765,000 request submitted by the Madison County Board of County Commissioners for Community Project Funding in the fiscal year 2023 Federal Budget for their sanitary sewer service project for the community of Sommerford in Madison County.

Sommerford is an unincorporated area in Madison County, which needs sanitary sewer service to serve the residents and homes in the area. Extending public sewer lines will help alleviate a long-term public health concern due to possible contamination of onsite private wells from onsite private septic systems in a high-density housing setting. This project would provide sanitary sewer service to an area of the county, which does not exist today, including in Sommerford, which is a low to moderate income community with a median household income below the Ohio average household level. Due to these economic constraints, we are seeking funding support to eliminate any additional financial burdens caused by the needed expansion of the residents of a Low to Moderate Income Community.

In addition to the health benefits to area residents the project will also support future growth through both residential and commercial development, which is limited today due to the lack of modern sewer service.

I hope that you will support Madison County's request for Community Project Funding in the fiscal year 2023 Federal budget for the Sommerford Sanitary Sewer Project.
