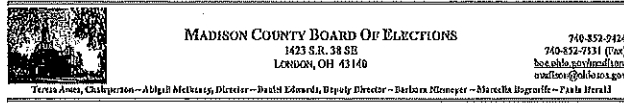

Agreement - Approved - Job & Family Services

This Agreement is made this 1st day of October, 2018, between ACUMAX, INC. ("AcuMax") and OHIO MEANS MADISON COUNTY ("Ohio Means Madison County").

- 1. **Definitions**
 - a. **Agreement** means this Agreement and any amendments thereto, as may be amended from time to time by the parties.
 - b. **AcuMax** means ACUMAX, INC., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Colorado.
 - c. **Ohio Means Madison County** means OHIO MEANS MADISON COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Ohio.
 - d. **Client** means the individual or entity that is the subject of the services provided by AcuMax.
 - e. **Company** means the entity that is the subject of the services provided by Ohio Means Madison County.
 - f. **Proprietary Information** means any information, including but not limited to, trade secrets, confidential information, and other information that is owned by or on behalf of AcuMax and is confidential, proprietary, or otherwise subject to a duty of confidentiality.
- 2. **Term and Termination**
 - a. This Agreement shall commence on the date hereof and shall continue in full force and effect until terminated by either party.
 - b. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time upon written notice to the other party.
 - c. In the event of termination, AcuMax shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees and costs incurred in connection with the termination of this Agreement.
- 3. **Assignment**
 - a. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties and their respective successors, assigns, and legal representatives.
- 4. **Entire Agreement**
 - a. This Agreement, including any amendments thereto, shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties and shall supersede all other agreements, understandings, and communications, whether written or oral, relating to the subject matter hereof.
- 5. **Severability**
 - a. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable or invalid, such provision shall be deemed to be severed from this Agreement, and the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 6. **Force Majeure**
 - a. In the event of a force majeure event, the parties agree to suspend the performance of their obligations under this Agreement for the duration of the event.
- 7. **Dispute Resolution**
 - a. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

- 8. **Confidentiality**
 - a. Client warrants that it has the right to collect, disclose, and store information or data relative to the Extended Index Group entered into the Web-Based Application, and that storage, processing and access to such data by Company does not violate the rights of any third party. Client grants Company permission to access, store, and process such data under this Agreement and to reference Client as an Acute Care Client.
- 9. **Breach**
 - a. Failure to pay any fee due under this Agreement shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.
 - b. Use of Proprietary Information in a way not allowed under this Agreement shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.
 - c. Client's failure to comply with any part of this Agreement shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.
- 10. **Access upon Breach**
 - a. In addition to any other remedies provided, Company may, at its discretion, terminate this Agreement and/or restrict access to the Web-Based Application upon breach and shall provide prompt notice to Client of any such decision.
 - b. Client shall, upon notice of termination of this Agreement, immediately cease using the Proprietary Information and shall, within ten (10) days of notice of termination, return all Proprietary Information of Company.
 - c. Client may obtain a final report of AcuMax reports generated prior to the termination of this Agreement upon payment of any unpaid fees due and an hourly fee, to be determined by Company, for the time and effort in producing these reports. Client may not modify the reports obtained nor remove any text or marks identifying them as AcuMax reports.
- 11. **Governing Law**
 - a. This Agreement will be governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, without regard to such State's principles concerning the conflict of laws. The parties consent to the personal and exclusive jurisdiction of the federal and state courts of Michigan.
- 12. **Severability and Construction**
 - a. The parties hereby waive any provision of law that would render any clause of this Agreement invalid or otherwise unenforceable in any respect. In the event that a provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, such provision will be interpreted to fulfill the intended purpose to the maximum extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions of this Agreement will continue in full force and effect. The Agreement shall be construed as being jointly drafted by the parties for purposes of judicial construction or enforcement.
- 13. **Entire Agreement, Amendment and Assignment**
 - a. This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous negotiations, representations, and discussions with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement may only be modified by an Amendment to this Agreement signed by both parties. Client may not assign this Agreement, or any rights and responsibilities without Company's written permission.






