**Minutes**

President Chris Wallace called the meeting of the Board of Commissioners to order at 8:36am.

**Commissioners present:** Mr. Chris Wallace, Dr. Tony Xenikis and Mr. Brendan Shea

**County representatives present:** Rob Slane, County Administrator; Nick Adkins, County Prosecutor; John Swaney, County Sheriff and Amy Rees, County Clerk

The minutes of July 22, 2025, regular meeting were approved as written.

**John Swaney, Madison County Sheriff**

- Sheriff's Deputies were involved in a vehicle pursuit that extended into Clark County. Due to inclement weather, the vehicle was lost during the pursuit. It was later recovered by Clark County Sheriff's Deputies, and one individual was apprehended.

**Nick Adkins, Madison County Prosecutor**

- Explained that the accounting error involving a property tax assessment that caused the recent tax settlement not to balance was corrected by recertifying the settlement with the correction.

**Rob Slane, Madison County Administrator**

- Stated that he received a proposal for roofing materials and services to repair the exterior of the Common Pleas Courthouse and, based on pricing, qualifications, and the scope administered under a cooperative purchasing agreement, recommended that Madison County proceed with Trisco Systems (through Garland/DBS) for the restoration project. Trisco submitted the lowest bid and offers the best overall value for both the base project and the proposed alternates.
- Explained the options for mailing a postcard to notify the public of the upcoming Comprehensive Plan meetings and where to view proposed zoning code changes. Two options were considered: bulk mail to all residents or Every Door Direct Mail (EDDM) to all addresses in Madison County. It was noted that EDDM would reach more people. Commissioner Shea moved to proceed with mailing the postcard via EDDM. Commissioner Xenikis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

**Open Session/Public Comments**

**Resolution 371-25** - Presented on behalf of Jennifer Hunter, Madison County Auditor - A Resolution Approving the Payment of Invoices for the Madison County Auditor

Commissioner Xenikis moved to approve the payment of invoices for the Madison County Auditor. Commissioner Shea seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously with a roll call vote.

**Resolution 372-25** - Presented on behalf of Dan Brown, Madison County Facilities Maintenance Superintendent - A Resolution Approving the Donation of Sick Leave from Ken White to Michael Bentley

Commissioner Shea moved to approve the donation of sick leave from Ken White to Michael Bentley. Commissioner Xenikis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously with a roll call vote.

**Resolution 373-25** - Presented on behalf of Holly Langham, Madison County Emergency Management Agency - A Resolution Approving the Appointment of Members to the Madison County Local Emergency Planning Committee

Commissioner Shea moved to approve the appointment of members to the Madison County Local Emergency Planning Committee. Commissioner Xenikis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously with a roll call vote.

Commissioner Wallace moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:30am. Commissioner Xenikis seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously with a roll call vote.
